Newborn Session Information Sheet

Booking

Newborn sessions are most effective between 5 and 10 days but any time in the first 2 weeks is fine. After this I can still get some gorgeous images it is not so easy to get those sleepy, snuggly newborn positions. I would therefore recommend booking your newborn session as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. We can amend the appointment, if necessary, if baby arrives earlier or later than expected (which most of them do!).

A session fee of £65 for weekday sessions or £75 for weekend sessions is required at the time of booking to secure your session. On receipt of your booking fee I will send you a welcome pack confirming your session and providing the studio address and any other information you may need for your session.

Location

Most sessions take place in the comfort of my studio in rural East Hertfordshire as I have all my lighting equipment, backdrops and props available. There is plenty of secure parking available. Location sessions can be arranged at an additional fee, please call me to discuss.

Duration

Newborn sessions usually take between 2 and 3 hours so please make sure you have kept enough time available. A happy and relaxed newborn is not a rushed one and I make sure there is plenty of time for feeding, changing and cuddles. Obviously I will try to keep your session as short as possible but I also do not clock watch and I do not book any other sessions on a newborn day so that you have my undivided attention. For this reason I do not offer newborn sessions at the weekend.

How should I prepare?

Babies look their cutest in their birthday suit or swaddled in a wrap so you don't need to worry about outfits for baby. I will provide plenty of blankets, hats and props, however, if there is a particular comfort toy or blanket/outfit that you would like a photograph with please bring it along.

If you are not breast feeding baby please bring an extra bottle or two as it may be required to help baby settle during the session. I keep the studio warm to help keep baby comfortable when unclothed and this can also lead to baby being thirsty and feeding a bit more.

I do always provide refreshments but please feel free to bring your own, especially if you have any particular dietary requirements. It's important for new Mums to keep hydrated and to eat regularly so please feel free to tuck in at any time during your session.



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I highly recommend having a photograph taken of yourselves with the baby. I understand that you will probably not be feeling at your best just after having a baby but in a few years time you may wish that you had taken the opportunity. A very flattering set up is a black backdrop, subtle lighting and some skin to skin head and shoulder shots so a strapless or thin strapped top for Mum and black t-shirt or bare chest for Dad. Neutral coloured outfits (whites, creams, beiges and browns) are also very flattering for photographs with your newborn. Please be assured that I will be very careful about ensuring any remaining baby tummy is not in the images!

If this is not your first baby you will probably also want some photographs with siblings. I usually ask for the siblings to attend for either the first or last part of the session if possible as it's a long time to expect them to sit in the studio. However I do appreciate that this is not always an option, especially if you are travelling a bit of a way to me. I have found that an iPad/tablet loaded with some games and favourite TV programmes usually helps!

What should the siblings wear?

Little boys look great wearing just jeans or trousers with no top or a plain t-shirt/shirt and girls look fabulous in a pretty white, pastel or floral dress or top and leggings. I usually take the sibling images on a cream or other neutral backdrop. If you prefer a bit more colour that's fine, they are your photos and stripes and checks can look really good but please steer clear of patterns or logos and please ensure that the outfits complement each other.

Little Accidents

There will be accidents so please don't worry. Wee, poop and possetting are all part and parcel of a newborn session, it's what babies do! It's not a problem. I have my own children and have been there and done it so please don't give it a second thought.

Sneak Peek

I usually aim to get an image on the blog or Facebook page the same or following day for you to see, providing you are willing to sign a consent form at the end of the session. The remainder of your images will be available to view in an online gallery within 2-3 weeks of your session date and I will email you a link to the gallery when they have been uploaded. Orders must be placed within 2 weeks of the date your online gallery becomes available. Your finished products will be ready for collection or delivery 2 to 4 weeks after your order has been placed.
